

Body of Evidence System

As a result of various conversations between the State Board of Education, the Wyoming Department of Education and the Task Force, there were a series of regional meetings during 2007-2008 to provide support and professional development to districts with their assessment systems, including Body of Evidence.

The workshops focused on 1) understanding the design of standards based assessment systems; 2) understanding the requirements of the design criteria of Body of Evidence; and 3) reviewing different approaches districts are considering to meet the criteria. The project was implemented in three phases from fall 2007 through fall 2009.

Districts are no longer required to use the Body of Evidence System to provide evidence of proficiency toward graduation requirements.
