Learn how to make an art project using newspaper and paste. Carefully read about the supplies you will need and follow the directions to complete a mask made from papier-mâché.

How to Make a Papier-Mâché Mask

Introduction

Make art from papier-mâché by soaking newspaper in paste and forming a shape, or sticking the newspaper onto a form, or object. When the newspaper dries, it hardens to form a surface you can paint. Follow the directions provided to make your own papier-mâché art project.

Paste Supplies

- 1 cup flour
- 2 cups water
- 1 teaspoon salt
- Large plastic bowl
- Wooden spoon

Make Papier-Mâché Paste

- 1. Combine 1 cup of flour, 2 cups of water, and 1 teaspoon of salt in a large plastic bowl. Use a wooden spoon to mix completely. Mixture should appear thick like white school glue.
- 2. Set aside until Step 4 of "Make a Papier-Mâché Mask."

Mask Supplies

- Sheets of newspaper, 4–5 sheets torn into about 50 strips (1–2 inches wide by 6–8 inches long)
- Gallon milk jug, rinsed and dried
- Scissors, for use by an adult
- Marker

- Papier-mâché paste-follow instructions for making papier-mâché paste
- Paint, different colors
- Paintbrush
- Cup, filled half full with water
- Paper towels, 1-2 sheets

Make a Papier-Mâché Mask

Steps

- 1. Cover your workspace with the sheets of newspaper.
- 2. Ask an adult to use the scissors to cut the milk jug in half. Use the half of the milk jug with the handle as the form for your mask.
- 3. Use the marker to draw the outline of eyeholes on each side of the handle. Have an adult cut the eyeholes out of the form. Use Picture 1 as a guide.



Tip: You may want to use the milk jug handle as a nose for your mask.

- 4. Stir the papier-mâché paste before using.
- 5. Dip a newspaper strip into the papier-mâché paste. Cover the newspaper strip with papier-mâché paste completely.
- 6. Use two fingers to gently wipe off extra papier-mâché paste from the newspaper strip.
- 7. Lay the newspaper strip onto the mask form. Use your fingers to smooth out air bubbles between the newspaper strip and the mask form.
- 8. Repeat Steps 5-7 to cover the entire mask form with a layer of newspaper strips.

- 9. Allow layer to dry completely.
- 10. Repeat Steps 4-7 to apply a second layer of newspaper strips.
- 11. Allow the second layer to dry completely before painting. Picture 2 shows how the mask should appear before you paint.



- 12. Use the paintbrush and one color paint to begin decorating your mask.
- 13. Dip your paintbrush in the cup of water to remove paint from the paintbrush.
- 14. Dry the paintbrush with paper towels before you select a different color of paint.
- 15. Allow painted mask to dry completely for about 2 hours.

Clean Up

- 1. Pour extra papier-mâché glue into the trash and pour the water in the sink.
- 2. Clean and dry paintbrush.
- 3. Wash large plastic bowl, wooden spoon, and water cup. Dry items and put them away.
- 4. Throw away gallon milk jug scraps, extra newspaper strips, newspaper sheets, and paper towels.
- 5. Put away scissors, marker, paint, and paintbrush.


