SUBJECT: Hathaway Success Curriculum Requirements Update

IMPORTANT INFORMATION - PLEASE SHARE

During the 2013 legislative session, House Bill 177, which is now Enrolled Act 118, was passed and signed into law. Enrolled Act 118 introduces changes to the Hathaway Success Curriculum (HSC). This year's high school freshmen and all subsequent graduating classes will be affected by this change. Seniors graduating in 2013, 2014, or 2015 are not affected by this change.

Students who will graduate in 2016 and beyond will need to meet additional HSC requirements which are outlined in the attached document entitled, "HB177-EA118 HSC Overview."

All current HSC requirements (as of 2011) for the Honors and Performance levels of the Hathaway Scholarship are the same. Beginning with the graduating class of 2016, students will need to complete all of the 2011 requirements *plus* two additional years of foreign language or two years of Fine & Performing Arts or two years of Career/Technical Education.

All current HSC requirements (as of 2011) for the Opportunity and Provisional Opportunity levels of the Hathaway Scholarship are the same with the exception of the foreign language proficiency requirement. Beginning with the graduating class of 2016, students will need to complete all of the 2011 requirements in math, language arts, science, and social studies. In lieu of the current foreign language proficiency requirements, students will choose two sequenced years of

foreign language <u>or</u> two years of Fine & Performing Arts or two years of Career/Technical Education.

Districts will determine which Fine & Performing Arts and Career/Technical Education courses will be used to satisfy these additional Hathaway Success Curriculum requirements and will designate those classes on the student's final high school transcript.
