High school students graduating in 2010 must meet the following requirements for the Career Level scholarship: Students must meet High School graduation requirements in all categories.

Opportunity Level (\$800/semester)

High School GPA: 2.50 ACT: 19

High school students graduating in 2010 must meet the following requirements for the Opportunity Level scholarship: Students must meet High School graduation requirements in all categories.

Performance or Honors Level (\$1200/semester; \$1600/semester)

Performance – High School GPA: 3.0 / ACT: 21 Honors – High School GPA: 3.5 / ACT: 25 High school students graduating in 2010 must meet the following requirements for the Performance & Honors Level scholarship:

Math – Students must complete three years of Math which must include Algebra I, Algebra II, and Geometry *Language Arts* – Students must meet High School graduation requirements.

Science - Students must complete three years of any of the following Science courses: Physical Science, Physics I, Physics II, Chemistry I, Chemistry II, Biology II, Geology I, Computer Science I.

Social Studies – Students must meet High School graduation requirements which includes courses covering the following subject matter: American History and World History

Foreign Language – Students must complete one year of Foreign Language which is to be taken in grades 9-12. The native language of the Eastern Shoshone or the Northern Arapahoe, or American Sign Language (ASL) may be taken in fulfillment of this requirement.

*There are five different categories within the Hathaway Success Curriculum. They are Math, Language Arts, Science, Social Studies, and Foreign Language.
