TIME SENSITIVE MATERIAL

The application process is now open for participation in the Wyoming Healthy Student Success Model. This coordinated school health collaborative agreement between state partnerships and schools or districts has as its mission “enhancing academic success for all students through coordinated school health.” Currently, there are eleven sites around the state participating in the process. First year data has been encouraging, showing decreases in discipline referrals, increased test scores and other academic measures. WHSSM is a systems approach to facilitating school success by recognizing that there is a link between health and learning. There are currently three WHSSM slots available for school year 2007/2008. The deadline for applications is January 25, 2008. The application is short and simple to complete.
