Grounded in research and practice, this one-day workshop will provide practical tools to help after-school coordinators and staff develop and implement effective summer programs that advance learning. In this interactive workshop, participants will understand how research about summer learning loss can inform their practice to improve program quality. Participants will also learn how to plan meaningful, engaging programming that integrate arts, culture, academics, youth development, recreation and community resources.

The training facilitators are from Johns Hopkins University, Center for Summer Learning.

The training will begin at 10:00 a.m. and end at 3:30 pm.

There is no registration fee for this workshop.
