The embargoed copy of the Every Student Counts (ESC) report form 2009-2010 school year will be posted Monday, March 28, 2011, for school district review. ESC is the school, district, and state level report card required by No Child Left Behind and the uniform school and district report required by state law.

Every Student Counts is embargoed until April 29, 2011, to provide districts with the opportunity to review the report and ensure data reporting accuracy.
