SUBJECT: 2nd Annual Native American Education Conference

IMPORTANT INFORMATION TO SHARE

Announcing the upcoming 2nd Annual Wyoming Native American Education Conference scheduled for October 27-28, 2011 to be held at Fremont County School District #14, Wyoming Indian High School, Ethete, WY. The conference is designed for educators and community partners serving Native American students. However, many issues and topics are relevant to students across Wyoming, such as anti-bullying efforts, working with community partners to promote education as a community priority, engaging and involving parents and working with students who live in poverty. Participants will also have an opportunity to learn about culture, traditions, language and current affairs on the Wind River Indian Reservation.

In a joint project between the Wyoming Department of Education and each of the individual Tribal Governments (Northern Arapaho and Eastern Shoshone Business Councils), we have determined that there are significant numbers of Native American students beyond the Fremont County School Districts, across the State of Wyoming. With that information, we have opened up this conference to any district. Conference sessions will be designed for educators or administrators, boards, parents and community partners.

The conference is a sponsored by the Wyoming Department of Education, Fremont County School District #1, Fremont County School District #6, Fremont County School District #14, Fremont County School District #21, Fremont County School District #25, Fremont County School District #38 and St. Stephens Indian School. All other participating districts will be required to pay \$100.00 per registrant.
