SUBJECT: School Safety Anonymous Tip Line (WeTip) Student Cards

ACTION REQUESTED

The Department of Education is providing anonymous tip line (WeTip) cards for older Wyoming students. These cards have the 1-800-78-CRIME number they can call to warn of danger or notify law enforcement if they have information that can solve or prevent certain crimes. With your help, we can become better at preventing and solving crime.

In order to promote statewide school safety measures, the following actions are requested:

1. Please ensure that each one of your students in middle school/junior high and high school receives a card.
2. Please ensure that each student understands that it is important to warn schools of danger they may know about. Please integrate the number into the schools' approach to safety and encourage students to keep the number in an easy-to-access place.
