The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) will host the fourth annual Native American Conference, August 8-9 in Riverton. The Conference will be held on the campus of Central Wyoming College.

This conference is routinely attended by nearly 250 participants who are interested in learning strategies for how to best meet the needs of Native American students. Last year presentations covered everything from cyber-bullying to holistic, tribal-based methods of mentoring.

The WDE is seeking presenters for the conference with slots lasting approximately one hour and 15 minutes. The presentations should be culturally relevant. Presentations related to the Shoshone and Arapahoe culture are encouraged. Proposals may be made by either groups or individuals and honorariums and travel support will be provided on an individual basis.
