RE: Notice of Intent and Public Comment Period for
Repeal of Chapter 13 Rules

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) is proposing the repeal of Chapter 13 - Bonded Indebtedness Mill Levy Supplement Rules and Regulations. During the 2010 general session, the Legislature amended W.S. 21-15-105(b) to restrict the mill levy supplement to bonds issued on or before February 23, 2001 and refunds of those bonds prior to April 1, 2010. Chapter 13 rules are no longer relevant as there are no longer any school districts applicable to the funding that the rules govern.

Please see the attached Notice of Intent to Repeal Rules for Chapter 13 governing Bonded Indebtedness Mill Levy Supplement. The WDE will be accepting public comment from **December 26, 2013 through February 10, 2014**. The state will review and consider all public comments.
