UW AGREEMENT PROVIDES FREE ESRI SOFTWARE USE FOR K-12 SCHOOLS

In November 2014, the University of Wyoming (UW) and Environmental Systems Research Institute Inc. (ESRI) signed a software license agreement which gives all K-12 public schools in Wyoming access to geographic information system (GIS) technology. This technology will help students gain valuable skills on software they may use in their careers in the near future.

The statewide license agreement is administered by UW's Wyoming Geographic Information Science Center (WyGISC). Through the agreement, Wyoming public schools will have free access to GIS software, e-training opportunities, and technical support services to aid in teaching and research activities.
