The HOBY Wyoming Leadership Seminar will be held at Laramie County Community College (LCCC), Cheyenne, Wyoming, June 4 – 7, 2015. The Registration Kit contains Frequently Asked Questions. Registration can be done online; all you need is your student's completed Registration Worksheet, your school ID and password. Registration costs \$195.00 per student.

HOBY Ambassadors receive lodging for the entire weekend, three meals a day, educational training materials and supplies, a t-shirt, and more. While the typical, all-inclusive cost per student is approximately \$400, the registration fee is significantly less than the true cost of attendance. As they do each year, volunteers from your community work hard to raise funds for the difference between the actual cost and the registration fee.
