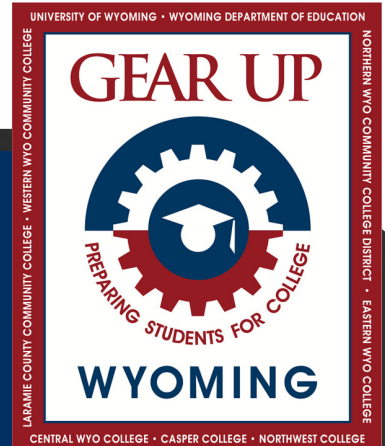

About Quantum Learning for Teachers:

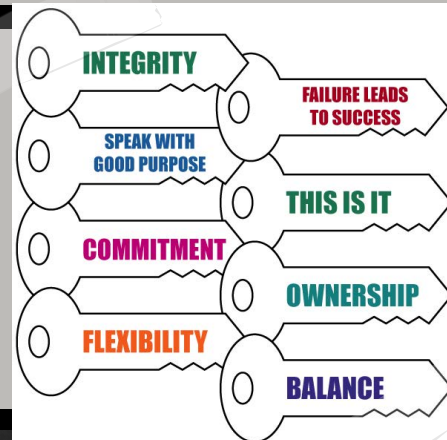
