# WDE KINDERGARTEN READINESS DATA COLLECTION

## **DUE MAY 27**

The Kindergarten Readiness Data Collection is completed by teachers in districts that provide a preschool program in accordance with <u>Wyoming §21-4-302</u>. The collection is available to any school district that opts to collect and utilize the data.

The collection is a combination of the Children's Progress Academic Assessment (CPAA) and the Instructional Foundations for Kindergarten (IF-K) that assesses each child. The CPAA targets key areas including reading and math. The IF-K focuses on areas identified in readiness research including language, social problem solving, relationships and self-regulation, science and representation.

The administration window for the CPAA for all students entering Kindergarten in Fall 2016 will open April 4 and must be completed by May 27. Staff are required to complete one of the following sessions prior to administration. These sessions are available to staff that were unable to complete training last fall.

The IF-K is an observation assessment and will be administered at the beginning of the Fall 2016 school year.
