SUBJECT: Chapter 8 and Chapter 41 Emergency Rules & Regulations

EMERGENCY RULES: SCHOOL FOUNDATION PROGRAM & DISTANCE EDUCATION

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) Chapter 8 School Foundation Program and Chapter 41 Distance Education Emergency Rules & Regulations became effective July 25, 2017. The emergency rules were written to address [House Enrolled Act 0125](#) and [Senate Enrolled Act 0057](#) which changed the manner in which districts calculate part-time membership and virtual education average daily membership. Both acts were effective July 1, 2017.

The WDE is working on regular rules revisions for both chapters and anticipates that these revisions will be ready for public comment in fall 2017. The emergency rules will be effective through 5 p.m. on November 22, 2017.
