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Enrollment in Wyoming schools on the rise

CHEYENNE – Fueled by the largest kindergarten class in its history, public schools in Wyoming saw its enrollment grow in 2012-13 by more than 1,500 students. According to data released today by the Wyoming Department of Education (WDE), there are 90,993 students attending schools this year in the Cowboy State.

According to the WDE, there are 8,131 students attending Wyoming kindergartens in the year 2012-13, which marks the fifth year in a row the state has seen record kindergarten enrollment.

"We knew, according to census data, that we would likely have a big year of kindergarten enrollment," said Leslie Zimmerschied, data analyst for the WDE. "While the census data leads us to believe we are unlikely to continue this trend of record-breaking kindergarten classes, we do expect kindergarten enrollment to remain higher than average."

The rise in enrollment rates is consistent with a seven-year trend during which the state has seen its total enrollment increase over 7,000 students since the 2005-06 school year. Historically, Wyoming's largest enrollment came in 1993 when the state saw 100,899 students in its schools. The enrollment numbers declined to 83,701, a state low in 2005-06.

According to the data, Laramie County District #1 remains the state's largest with an enrollment of 13,387 students. Natrona County District #1 is the state's second largest at 12,750. Campbell County District #1 (8,705), Sweetwater County District #1 (5,514) and Albany County District #1 (3,657) round out a list of the state's five largest districts.

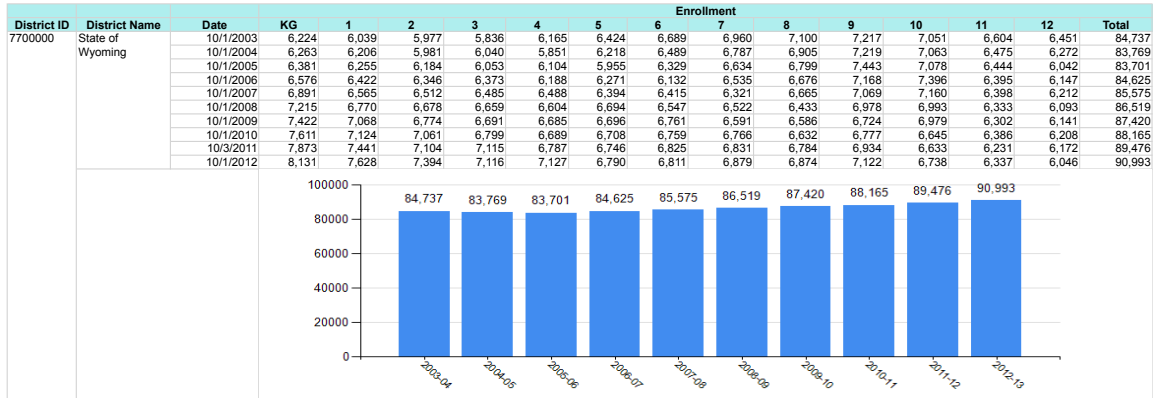
Sheridan County District #3 remains the state's smallest district with an enrollment of 90 students. Washakie County District #2 (109) and Park County District #16 (117) are the second and third smallest of the state's 48 districts.

The WDE uses enrollment data as part of a formula for school block grant funding and the student-level data also drives statistics such as the state's student-to-teacher ratio, Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP), National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP), and Proficiency of Wyoming Students (PAWS). Enrollment data are collected through the WDE684 Collection and is made public through the state's online Statistical Report Series #2.

The enrollment numbers are collected by the Wyoming Department of Education's WDE684 information collection which were reported by districts on Oct. 1, 2012. The enrollment is a student-level collection, which counts each individual student including their enrollment and demographic information.
