State Board of Education to meet Sept. 26-27 in Jackson

CHEYENNE - The Wyoming State Board of Education will meet Sept. 26-27 at the Snow King Resort in Jackson. The Snow King Resort is located at 400 East Snow King Ave., Jackson, Wyoming.

The Board will hold a work session on Sept. 26 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Among the topics the board will review during the work session are: an update from the State Board of Education Coordinator; a report from the legislative subcommittee; information on dual immersion; the direction of assessment and End of Course; the board's strategic plan, a Chapter 31 update and information the Oct. 15 report to the Legislature.

The Board will hold its regular board meeting on Sept. 27 from 9:30 a.m. to 2:45 p.m.

During the regular state board meeting, the Board will receive information and updates on the Wyoming Fine and Performing Arts Content and Performance Standards; district certified personnel evaluation systems; Hathaway Success curriculum, BOCES/BOCHES agreements, policy manual, board updates, recommendation for a new provider of court-ordered placement of students; revisions of Chapter 14 rules and regulations, and the November 2012 State Board of Education meeting.
