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Regional Summits on Educational Accountability Slated For This Fall

CHEYENNE - The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) and State Board of Education will partner this fall for 13 sessions offered around the state updating stakeholders on the Wyoming Accountability in Education Act.

Wyoming's Summit on Education Accountability are a series of meetings committed to providing outreach to educational professionals and community members from across the state regarding accountability efforts in its beginning.

The Board of Education and the WDE plan to offer two sets of informational meetings, which would satisfy the requirements of Section 5(f) of the 2013 Educational Accountability Act Amendments (Interim Study Priority number 10). These meetings will be held face-to-face in five sites around the states as well as online through the WDE's Blackboard Collaborate tool in hopes of accommodating the largest number of interested stakeholders.

"I think it is important that any time you are doing something across the state, you keep the stakeholders and the people around the state as involved as we can possibly do it," said State Board of Education Chair, Ron Micheli. "Generally speaking when there is a void in information or lack of input from around the state, the vacuum tends to be filled sometimes with misinformation, so it is important that we do everything we can to keep the people and the stakeholders involved."

Meetings scheduled for August will include discussion on elements of the WAEA, which are to be presented at the Oct. 24-25, 2013 meeting of the Wyoming Legislature's Joint Education Committee. The aim is to gather insight from those who attend, foster two-way communication and help educators move forward with implementing elements of the WAEA.

These meetings will observe the following tentative agenda:

Another group of meetings will take place after the Professional Judgement Panel (PJP) convenes in Casper, Sept. 16-18. These meetings are scheduled to be more focused in time and scope and will share the results of the PJP and explain how the decisions made by the PJP will impact individual schools. Stakeholder feedback will be recorded and shared with the State Board of Education.

The PJP is a 27-member panel of teachers, administrators and members from higher education as well as the business community. Their role is to set cut scores for each of the indicators to help categorize schools as exceeding expectations, meeting expectations or below expectations. The PJP will meet in September to set the targets.
