CHEYENNE - The Wyoming Advisory Panel for Students with Disabilities (WAPSD) will hold a public meeting February 13-14, 2014 in Cheyenne.

The event is slated to take place over two days. On Feb. 13, it will go from 1-5 p.m. and again from 8 a.m.-noon on Feb. 14. The Center for Conferences and Institutes at the Laramie County Community College, 1400 East College Drive in Cheyenne will host both days of meetings.

The WAPSD panel serves as a forum by which issues and benefits regarding current and potential services to individuals with disabilities are discussed.
