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### Program Description

Learn It Systems, LLC (Learn It) offers three programs to provide families with the flexibility to meet their needs: (1) Learn It Advantage - face-to-face direct instruction in small groups at your child's school; (2) Learn It Online – live, small-group sessions over the internet with U.S. based instructors using Voice over Internet Protocol and an interactive whiteboard; and (3) Learn It Blended – a combination of computer-assisted and live instructional sessions. Our programs are proven effective: students who have completed our programs demonstrate an average increase of 37% in math and 30% in reading on their post-assessments. Additionally, 99% of parents who responded to our surveys said they were pleased with Learn It's programs.
