Incorrect usage of Whole milk or 2% Milk Disallowance Policy

PURPOSE:

To set forth the Wyoming policy regarding the purchasing and serving of 2% milk or whole milk to children 2 years old and older found at a CACFP center during the review process. If any part of this policy conflicts with the regulations or memoranda issued by the USDA, the federal regulations and memoranda shall take precedence.

SCOPE:

This relates to participating CACFP centers and Sponsors of CACFP affiliated and unaffiliated centers of a Sponsoring Organization.

DESCRIPTION:

Determined on a review:

The Wyoming Department of Education will take away the meals that require milk to be reimbursable for the entire month of review if it is determined by receipts that the CACFP center or site is purchasing only 2% milk and/or whole milk for children that are 2 years old or older.

If it is stated on the production records that 2% milk and/or whole milk is being served but on the receipts 1% or fat free milk is being purchased for children 2 years old and older it will be a finding but no meals will be taken away for this reason.
