

 - Statistical significance = reliable difference






Wyoming Writing Results: For 2007 and Since 1998






Percentages at NAEP Achievement Levels and Average Score

Writing Scores at Selected Percentiles in Wyoming





NOTE: Scores at selected percentiles on the NAEP writing scale indicate how well students at lower, middle, and higher levels performed.

Focal state/jurisdiction (Wyoming)


Higher average scale score than Wyoming (6 jurisdictions)


Not significantly different from Wyoming (15 jurisdictions)

Lower average scale score than Wyoming (nation and 24 jurisdictions)








Current per-pupil expenditures for elementary and secondary education in the United States: Fiscal year 2005






National and Cross-state Comparisons: Changes across reporting periods






Changes in Average Scores Compared With 2002



NAEP Grade 8 Writing - Change in Average Scale Score by Jurisdiction - 2002-2007


Changes in Average Scores Compared With 1998




Significant score increase No significant change Did not participate or did not meet the minimum participation guidelines for reporting

- No state decreases



NAEP Grade 8 Writing - Change in Percent at or above Proficient by Jurisdiction - 1998-2007


Gaps in Student Group Performance







Student Group Gaps


- Writing performance gaps remain unchanged did not widen, or narrow—in WY during 2007 from both the 2002 or 1998 assessment
 - Whites and Hispanics
 - Whites and American Indians
 - Female and male students
 - Non-school lunch eligible and free/reduced
- Gaps in Wyoming between Hispanic and White students still among of the nation's smallest




Comparing NAEP & State Assessments

- Different Purposes
 - Measuring individual student achievement (PAWS)
 - Providing an external reference, point-of-comparison (NAEP)
- Differing Content
 - Definition of construct (e.g., reading vs. language arts)
 - Composition of scales and subscales
 - Types of stimulus materials (e.g., reading passages)
- Different Formats/Assessment Procedures
 - Item types
 - Timing (NAEP is timed; PAWS is not)
- Different Reporting Metrics
 - Scales
 - Cut scores
- Consequences
 - AYP determinations for schools, districts (PAWS)
 - No accountability consequences attached (NAEP)
