State Board of Education to Convene in Casper

Cheyenne– The Wyoming State Board of Education (SBE) will meet Thursday, August 13, 2015 at the Wyoming Oil and Gas Commission located at 2211 King Boulevard, Casper.

The board will hold a work and business session from 8:30 a.m. to 5:45 p.m.

During the work session, the board will hear an update on the work of the Professional Judgement Panel, which is tasked with determining cut scores for the state education accountability model. Additionally, reports from the SBE coordinator, Wyoming Department of Education liaison, and SBE working committees will be heard.

A presentation from Pascal Public Relations on a proposed communication strategic plan will be given to the board. Pascal Public Relations was retained by the board in May 2015 to complete a series of interviews, surveys, and research to create the proposed plan.

Action items for this meeting include: restructuring plans from Uinta County School District (CSD) #1 and Fremont CSD #21, the proposed Statewide System of Support, certified professional evaluations, and finalization of the draft rules on district's request for accountability determination.
