State Board of Education to meet in Laramie

Cheyenne – The Wyoming State Board of Education will hold a meeting at the Albany County School District 1 office in Laramie, Wyoming on April 17-18, 2008. The meeting will be held in the board room. The address of the district office is 1948 Grand Avenue in Laramie, Wyoming

On April 17, the board will hold a study session from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. to discuss the commonalities between the State Board, the Wyoming Department of Education and the School Facilities Commission. They will receive an update on No Child Left Behind from Patricia Chlouber of the United States Department of Education and receive additional No Child Left Behind information regarding the reauthorization including growth models and differentiated accountability from Will Donkersgoed of the Wyoming Department of Education and fellow board member Dana Mann-Tavegia.

The board will also be setting their annual study priorities for the upcoming year. The board will convene into executive session at approximately 3 p.m. to discuss the upcoming Cheyenne Classical Academy charter school application appeal hearing.

The board will hold its regular business meeting on April 18 from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. During the meeting the members will receive an update on Fremont County School District 38 accreditation status and recommendations, be asked to approve a court ordered placement provider and visit with the 2008 Wyoming Teacher of the Year, Eileen Johnson
