State Board of Education to convene in Gillette

Cheyenne – The Wyoming State Board of Education will be meeting on Wednesday and Thursday, April 15 and 16, 2009, in the Campbell County School District 1 board room at 1000 West 8th Street in Gillette, Wyo.

There will be a work session from noon until 4 p.m. on Wednesday, April 15. The regular state board meeting will be Thursday, April 16, from 8:30 a.m. until 12:30 p.m.

During the work session, the board will receive information and updates on various legislative items, stimulus funding, budget issues, assessments and standards.

During the regular state board meeting, items covered will include presentations on school district restructuring reports and Fremont County School Districts' 21 and 38 charter statuses. The board will also take action on Chapter 29 and 32 rules and regulations.

In addition, the board will host and recognize Wyoming Teacher of the Year, Alice King of Gillette, during a banquet in her honor Wednesday evening.
