<u>Media Advisory</u> **Timeline for Cheyenne Classical Academy decision detailed**

What – The Wyoming State Board of Education will be holding two additional meetings via the WEN Video system regarding Cheyenne Classical Academy's appeal of a recent denial by the Laramie County School District 1 Board of Trustees of a charter school application. The first meeting will be the consideration and discussion of the arguments and briefings received by the Wyoming State Board of Education from both parties. The board will only be deliberating on the information and no formal decision will be made during the meeting. This meeting will take place on May 5, 2008.

The second meeting will be held on May 12, 2008. During this meeting, the Wyoming State Board of Education will vote to determine a final decision on the appeal.
