Cheyenne – The Wyoming State Board of Education will hold a meeting at Casper College on Nov. 13 and 14. The meeting will be held in the Strausner Student Center in room CE-207 on Nov. 13 and room CE-217 on Nov. 14.

On Nov. 13, the board will hold a study session from 1 to 5 p.m. to discuss the development and process of evaluating state standards. It will examine what constitutes high quality content and performance standards and discuss cognitive complexity in State Performance Standards.

The board will hold its regular business meeting on Nov. 14 from 8 a.m. to 2:45 p.m. During the meeting, the members will continue a focus on standards, as well as receive information on other items such as the Hathaway Scholarship, Distance Education and Body of Evidence.
