Bill Anthony receives Superintendent's Award

Cheyenne – Wyoming Superintendent of Public Instruction Dr. Jim McBride presented Wyoming Board of Education member Bill Anthony with the Wyoming Superintendent's Award during the board's regular business meeting last week.

The award was presented to Anthony for his cooperation, focused leadership and an unwavering commitment to improve student skills during his tenure as board chairman and his membership on the board.

His leadership as chairman was instrumental to Wyoming joining the consortium of Common Core Standards, as well as supporting the development of the new accreditation model for Wyoming schools.

Bill Anthony has a 36-year history in education in Wyoming as a teacher and administrator. Born and raised in Spearfish, SD, he taught Mathematics for 21 years, served 2 years as a junior high vice-principal, 9 years as a district-wide math/science coordinator and 2 years as a special assistant to the Superintendent in the area of curriculum and instruction. Additionally, he has served on the Wyoming School Facilities Commission.

He holds a bachelor of science degree from Black Hills Teachers College, a Masters of Education in Science from the University of New Mexico and Masters of Arts in Mathematics from the University of Michigan.

“Anthony is a strong leader who guided the board and Wyoming education down some new paths that our state has benefited from,” McBride said. “He has brought a number of people together over contentious issues so that they might work together to improve education in Wyoming.”
