## WHAT/WHO WILL BE THERE?

**Federal Programs** – The Federal Programs track will cover information targeted toward Superintendents, Principals, Grant Managers, and Business Managers. Some of the topics which will be covered are: Consolidated Grant Application/Grants Management System, School Improvement, Perkins Grants, Title I, Title II and Title III / WIDA updates.

**Instructional Support** – The Instructional Support track is targeted to all individuals who are involved in the education of our students. This would include not only teachers and administrators, but also parents - our first teachers. Some of the topics covered will include: Increasing School Safety, Standards Review, Balanced Literacy, School Improvement Plans for Accountability, Wyoming Trust Fund Grant Recipients Project Presentations, Special Education, and Assessment Updates and New Information.
