INFORMATION TO SHARE

The Governor's Office is seeking proposals for providing Wyoming with a statewide educational initiative on energy and natural resource development. The RFP is the result of Senate Enrolled Act 073, which was introduced by the Joint Education Interim Committee during the 2013 General Session and signed into law by the Governor on March 13, 2013.

The law is designed to form and implement a statewide energy and natural resource use, development, and stewardship program for use in public schools. The law appropriated \$75,000 from the School Foundation Program account to the Governor's Office to perform this task with specific criteria for the program to be obtained through feedback from industry representatives, state agencies and stakeholder groups.
