**SUBJECT:** No Child Left Behind Title II D Requirements

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### **DATA REQUIREMENTS ARE LIFTED!**

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) has received information from the U.S. Department of Education (USDE) that school districts no longer need to submit data required by the now de-funded Title II-D “Enhancing Education Through Technology” program. The program is component of No Child Left Behind. These data elements are not required to be reported to the USDE, and as such are not required of school districts by the State.

The data collections required by districts in WDE Form 588-School Technology Survey (Spring 2014) and WDE Form 584-District Technology Survey (Fall 2014) will no longer be collected by the Wyoming Department of Education.

In addition, school technology plans no longer need to be submitted to the WDE, effective immediately.

However, the state’s E-rate program, managed by Enterprise Technology Services (ETS), may still require this information to complete the annual state E-rate application. Further communication from ETS regarding E-rate requirements will be forthcoming.
