APPLICATIONS FOR THE CENTURYLINK "TEACHERS AND TECHNOLOGY" GRANT NOW OPEN

CHEYENNE - The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) is announcing the launch of the [CenturyLink Teachers and Technology grant](#) application process. From now until January 2nd, 2015, the WDE is accepting applications from all preK-12 Wyoming educators who reside in a CenturyLink residential service area. There is no limit to the number of teachers that can apply from each school.

All applicants have the opportunity to submit a proposal that requests funding, not to exceed \$5,000, for innovative projects that use technical equipment and/or training to enhance classroom learning activities. Applicants must submit a one-page narrative of how the technology will impact student performance, another one-page narrative of how purchases will enhance classroom activities, a third one-page narrative describing the sustainability plans and a budget spreadsheet.

All proposals will be read and judged by a committee of K-12 education professionals and CenturyLink employees. This committee will determine which applications best meet the funding criteria using the scoring rubric included in the application package. Applicants will be notified of the award committee's decision between April 1, 2015 and May 1, 2015. Funding will be awarded by May 15, 2015.
