CHEYENNE - Please consider encouraging your students to enter the Wyoming Junior Duck Stamp Competition.

One hundred places/prizes are awarded across Wyoming. Students are judged in four groups according to grade bands K-3, 4-6, 7-9, and 10-12. Three first-, three second-, and three third-place entries, along with 16 honorable mentions, are selected from each grade band. One "Best of Show" will advance to the National Junior Duck Stamp Contest in April to compete for scholarships and the chance to have their work printed. Last year, a high school student from Rock Springs placed second in the national contest.
