# STUDENT ASSESSMENT OF WRITING SKILLS (SAWS)

Enrolled Act 50 was signed into law on March 2, 2015 by Governor Mead. The new statute eliminates the Student Assessment of Writing Skills (SAWS) at grades 3, 5, and 7 from the statewide assessment system effective immediately. This means that the SAWS test scheduled for April 13 – May 1, 2015 is canceled.

Using 2015 prompts and anchor papers already developed under the SAWS program, WDE Standards and Assessment teams will be planning two-day professional development sessions in order to continue to support standards-based instruction relative to writing. These sessions will be offered regionally around Wyoming during the summer months of 2015. Announcements regarding these professional development opportunities will be made via the <a href="WDE website">WDE website</a> as well as through the weekly Assessment Updates.
