# RE-ENVISIONING WYOMING ENERGY EDUCATION

The University of Wyoming's College of Education and School of Energy Resources will provide professional development for integrating Wyoming K-12 Science and Social Studies Standards to develop energy literacy. This professional development opportunity will be offered in three sessions (Summer 2018, Fall 2018, and Spring 2019) in Casper. The first session is set for July 11-13, 2018.

The workshop includes:

- Strategies for integrating social studies and science through a focus on Wyoming Energy;
