ELIMINATION OF KEYBOARDING FROM CTE APPROVED COURSE LIST

The Wyoming Department of Education Career and Technical Education (CTE) section will no longer accept Keyboarding as a CTE Approved Course beginning **July 1, 2018**.

This change is driven by [2018 Senate Enrolled Act No. 48](#), which eliminates keyboarding from the common core of knowledge and skills.
