DIGITAL LEARNING GUIDELINES: CALL FOR WORK GROUP MEMBERS

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) seeks educators to participate in the development of digital learning guidelines for grades K-12. During the creation of the statewide [Digital Learning Plan](#), stakeholders expressed the need for guidelines to assist in meeting the digital learning needs of students across the grade spans, and the WDE is forming a work group of educators to address the request.

The Digital Learning Guidelines Work Group will meet in Cheyenne for two days in July and then virtually as needed to prepare a first draft of the guidelines, which will be presented at the [Innovations in Learning Conference](#) in November before being finalized. To review feedback and finalize the guidelines, a final virtual meeting will be scheduled before the end of November.
