REGISTER NOW FOR FACILITATING CAREER DEVELOPMENT COURSE

Registration is now open for the Wyoming Department of Education's Winter 2018-19 Facilitating Career Development Course. This is a 120-hour blended-format training that runs from October 25, 2018 to January 7, 2019. The course is geared toward school staff, counselors, administrators, and teachers who coordinate career guidance and exploration programming in their schools.

The course provides a complete set of National Career Development Association (NCDA) endorsed best practices for career guidance in multiple settings and for all ages. Those who complete the course will receive a certificate of completion and University of Wyoming graduate or PTSB credits. Participants are also eligible to apply for Global Career Development Facilitator credentials and/or Certified Career Services Specialist credentials.

The course supports the implementation of more robust career guidance programs in Wyoming schools, and ensures consistency in the delivery of content and best practices in career development. The course is offered every spring and winter.
