SUBJECT: Timelines for Alternative Schedule Requests

APPLICATION FOR ALTERNATIVE SCHEDULES

Alternative schedules that propose fewer than 175 days of teacher-student contact in a given school year need to be approved by the State Board of Education (SBE). Any district interested in applying for an alternative schedule for the 2019-20 and/or 2020-21 school year must submit a request with all required documentation to the Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) during one of the upcoming submittal windows.

Applications submitted by **March 4, 2018** will be presented to the SBE during its March meeting. The final opportunity to apply for the 2019-20 and/or 2020-21 school year is **May 1, 2018**. Applications received by this deadline will be presented to the SBE during its May meeting.

The application may be <u>submitted online</u> and a checklist of required documentation is attached.

Districts previously approved for an alternative schedule for the 2018-19 and 2019-20 school years must indicate their intent to continue the approved alternative schedule here.

Schools currently operating under an alternative schedule must submit the attached **end-of-year report to the WDE by July 1, 2019**. The end-of-year report indicates how the alternative
