SUBJECT: Computer Science Educator Certifications

COMPUTER SCIENCE CERTIFICATIONS REQUIRED FOR MATH AND SCIENCE COURSE CREDIT

In 2018, the Wyoming Legislature passed <u>Senate Enrolled Act</u> <u>48</u>, requiring all school districts to offer computer science courses. Computer science courses may count as a science graduation requirement or as an additional fourth year of math for the Hathaway Scholarship Program requirement.

Districts have posed questions relating to teacher certification requirements to provide science or math credit for students taking computer science courses. The Wyoming Department of Education has produced a <u>flowchart</u> to clarify the certification requirements. Please note the requirements will change once the computer science standards have been fully approved, as seen on page 2 of the attached.
