SUBJECT: BPX Energy Scholarship Opportunity for High School Students or First-Year College Freshman

BPX ENERGY SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITY

BPX Energy is currently offering scholarships for high school students or first year college freshman majoring in a Science, Technology, Engineering or Mathematics (STEM) field of study. Each scholarship is approximately \$5,000 for 2019. Applications must be received by February 15, 2019.

To be eligible, students must be:

- Majoring in a STEM field of study. Preference is given to students pursuing studies in areas of interest to the energy industry.
- A legal resident of the state of Wyoming. Preference is given to students from Carbon and Sweetwater Counties.
- A current high school senior planning to enroll full-time at the University of Wyoming, any Wyoming community college or the Colorado School of Mines in the fall of 2019, or
- A first-year freshman currently enrolled as a full-time student at the University of Wyoming, any Wyoming community college or the Colorado School of Mines in the fall of 2019.
