SCIENCE SURVEY, PD, & RESOURCES

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) is hosting a survey for school districts on the current implementation of the **2016 Wyoming** <u>Science Content Standards</u>. These standards are to be implemented in districts by the start of the 2020-21 school year. The first operational assessment of the standards will occur during the 2021 WY-TOPP (grades 4, 8, and 10), where they will begin counting toward student scores. The <u>survey</u> will be open through March 31, 2019.
