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DATA-BASED INDIVIDUALIZATION SUMMIT

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE), in collaboration with Region V BOCES and the National Center on Intensive Intervention (NCII), will offer a free, three-day training in Data-Based Individualization (DBI) on March 19-21 in Green River. The NCII will have two trainers on site: Dr. Tessie Rose Bailey and Dr. Amy Peterson. There is no cost for the training.

DBI is a research-based process designed for use with students with the most persistent learning needs by individualizing and intensifying interventions through the systematic use of assessment data, validated interventions, and research-based strategies.
