SUBJECT: Hathaway Success Curriculum Changes and Guidance

HATHAWAY SUCCESS CURRICULUM CHANGES AND GUIDANCE

Senate Enrolled Act 0020, passed in 2019, provides more flexibility for students to meet the Hathaway Success Curriculum requirements. The mandate that two of the four required electives include two sequenced years of a foreign language at the Honors and Performance levels has been rescinded. Instead, students may choose to take two sequenced years of Foreign Language, Career and Technical Education, or Fine and Performing Arts, followed by two years of additional electives in those categories. Additionally, students earning a Provisional Opportunity scholarship may qualify by passing a Career and Technical aptitude assessment, including, but not limited to, WorkKeys.

For 2019 and 2020 high school graduates, students may take either the current Success Curriculum or the new amended curriculum. The new Success Curriculum will take full effect in the 2021 school year.

The Chapter 38 Hathaway rules will be updated to reflect the above changes. Until this update occurs, refer to this **guidance** regarding course qualifications and sequencing.
