# 2019 GRADUATING STUDENT TRANSCRIPTS COLLECTION WINDOW OPENS SEPTEMBER 16

The 2019 WDE950 Graduating Student Transcripts Collection will take place from **September 16 - to October 15**. The WDE950 is the collection of transcripts for all grade 12 students who graduated in the 2018-19 school year. This collection fulfills the requirements of the Wyoming Accountability in Education Act Statute 21-2-204(c)(iv).

The data will be used for relationship studies to compare a student's high school grades, courses, and post-secondary performance as well as to determine each graduating student's Hathaway Scholarship eligibility. For accountability, this indicator, along with the other readiness indicators, will be used to calculate overall school performance ratings and identify schools for support under federal accountability requirements.
