# WYOMING DIGITAL LEARNING GUIDELINES NOW RELEASED

The Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) has released its Wyoming Digital Learning Guidelines to support education technology use in K-12 classrooms. The guidelines are an initiative from the statewide <u>Digital Learning Plan</u> and are based on the <u>ISTE Standards</u> <u>for Students</u>. While the guidelines may be used across all content areas, implementation is voluntary.

To support educators in implementing the guidelines in the classroom, the WDE will offer a free online course that features:

- Self-paced, interactive modules in the Canvas learning management system.
- One-half (.5) Professional Teaching Standards Board (PTSB) credit available upon completion.
- Open enrollment, so educators can join the course at their convenience.
