2018 CENSUS DATA FOR FY20 TITLE I, PART A ALLOCATIONS

The U.S. Department of Education released estimated census data for calculating Title I, Part A allocations for local educational agencies (LEA) for fiscal year 2020 (school year 2020-21).

This [memorandum](#) explains the purpose of the census data, and the process used to determine LEA eligibility and allocations. Census data information for 2017-18 is provided per [state](#) and 2018 census poverty data is provided for each Wyoming [school district](#). LEA review of the 2018 poverty data is important, as this information is used to determine eligibility and 2020-21 allocations for each LEA. LEAs are encouraged to verify the accuracy of the district boundary survey [here](#).

The Census Bureau established a challenge period for reviewing this data.
