# DOUVAS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 30

The Wyoming Department of Education is accepting applications for the Douvas Scholarship from February 1 to April 30. This scholarship, established by Greek immigrant Peter George Douvas, is awarded to a first-generation American with the motivation to attend college. One \$500 scholarship is awarded annually.

# Requirements:

- Students must be a first-generation American: a person born in the United States, but whose parents were not born in the United States.
- Be a high school senior or between the ages of 18 and 22.
- Be a Wyoming resident.
- Use the scholarship at one of the state's seven community colleges or the University of Wyoming.
- Use the scholarship to partially meet educational expenses during the school year that follows the spring application.

The scholarship recipient will be notified by the end of May, and the check will be mailed in August to the recipient's indicated college. Applications and additional information can be found here.
