POSITIVE SCHOOL CLIMATE GRANT OPPORTUNITY

In response to both an increasing national and state concern regarding reports of bullying and violence in schools and the needs of Wyoming school districts, the Wyoming Department of Education (WDE) will offer competitive grants to schools and districts that support anti-bullying and positive school climate efforts.

Any public school can apply for up to \$7,000 for the 2020-21 school year. The grant application opens on February 17, 2020, and is due on May 29, 2020. Initial award announcements will be made in July. The school climate [grant application](#) must be completed and submitted online.
